- 2016 No Shadow- Early Spring It was 28° at Gobbler's Knob. Phil made his prediction of an Early Spring at 7:25 a.m.
- 2017 7:25 a.m. Saw His Shadow, Six More Weeks of Winter! There were a few snow flurries during the prognostication.
